

COMMINGLED RECYCLABLES COLLECTION

GLASS



Three colored glass: clear, green or amber.

DOES NOT INCLUDE

China, crystal, mirrors, light bulbs, kitchen ware, window glass, broken glass, windshields, ceramics, pottery, pesticide/herbicide containers.

- Labels need not be removed.
- Please rinse out your containers and remove all lids and caps.
- Place all glass bottles and jars in **BLUE RECYCLING CONTAINER**.

INCLUDES

All glass bottles and jars (including wine, liquor, soda and juice)

METALS



Tin, aluminum and "bi-metal cans" (usually referred to as tin cans).

DOES NOT INCLUDE

Oil and paint cans, plastic dinner trays, aluminum siding, wire and auto parts, metal lids and caps, appliances, and batteries.

- Labels need not be removed
- Please rinse out your containers and remove all lids and caps.
- Place metals in **BLUE RECYCLING CONTAINER**.

INCLUDES

Food, juice, soup, fruit, vegetable and beverage cans, clean aluminum foil trays, and empty aerosol cans.

PLASTICS

Check bottom of your containers, bottles, etc. for the following two symbols. ONLY these two symbols are currently acceptable. More types may be added in the future.

Pet (Polyethylene Terephthalate) is clear. Examples include clear or green-tinted soda bottles.

HDPE (High Density Polyethylene) is never clear — it is either colored (e.g. detergent bottles) or translucent (e.g. dairy bottles) with a dull surface finish.

DOES NOT INCLUDE

Plastics stamped with:



Toys, oil bottles, plastic wrp, caps, lids, plastic foam, film, vinyl. No rigid containers of potentially hazardous materials such as motor oil or chlorine bleach, pesticide, etc.

- Labels need not be removed.
- Please rinse out containers and remove all lids and caps.
- Please put plastics in **BLUE RECYCLING CONTAINER**.
- PLEASE CRUSH ALL PLASTIC CONTAINERS, ESPECIALLY GALLON MILK JUGS**



INCLUDES

Milk and water containers, soda, detergent bottles, containers up to 2 gallon size.
